



## Application Process

- Student completes the application and submits a typed and signed essay of at least 150 words answering the question: “Why do you want to attend Middle College High School and how will this impact your future goals?”
- Student requests a current transcript from his/her high school counselor’s office and attaches it with his/her essay and the Parent/Student Agreement to the MCHS application and submits all documents to the MCHS office no later than May 1, 2017.
- Student requests a recommendation from one teacher and from his/her high school counselor. Recommendation forms are available online with the application.
- Student will submit ACT scores to the Middle College High School office. Sophomores may not take the ACT later than April 8 so that scores will be available by April. Juniors may take ACT in April at their high schools.
- Students who meet all criteria will be informed in May of interview or lottery dates if there are more qualified applicants than available spots in the MCHS program. Students who do not meet criteria will receive a letter to that effect in May.
- Students who are accepted into the program must attend an Orientation Day the end of May. A parent or guardian is required to attend with the student on this day.
