



Middle College High School ACT Requirement

ACT Testing Dates

High school juniors have the opportunity to take the ACT at their school in April. Please check with your high school counselor to make sure you are scheduled to take the test in April. Feel free to take the ACT earlier than April. No tests later than the April date will be accepted for juniors.

For fall admittance, sophomores must take the ACT no later than the April testing date. High school sophomores will have to take the test at a registered center and must register for the ACT under their current high school.

For students applying for spring semester, ACT scores must be available to the MCHS office at least one month before the semester begins.

Volunteer State is a registered test center. Go to the ACT website to register:

You only need to take the ACT (no writing).

To be eligible for Middle College High School you must make a composite of 19 or higher and on subtests; at least 19 in math, 19 in reading and 18 in English.
