



Prospective Middle College High School Student

Thank you for your interest in the Sumner County Middle College High School (MCHS) at Volunteer State. This partnership between Sumner County and Volunteer State is designed to enhance the missions of both institutions. Establishing a MCHS makes it possible for some high school students to have a more independent learning environment with unique features separate from a traditional high school. MCHS is designed to give students an opportunity to receive a high school diploma while earning credits toward a college degree or explore vocational and career options. This is also a high school for students who may better reach their full potential in a “non-traditional” school setting.

Student Criteria:

- **Student must be a enrolled in a Sumner County public school.**
- Students must have an ACT composite score of 19 or higher and sub-scores of at least math(19), English(18), and reading(19)
- Students must be entering their junior or senior year in high school.
- Students must be responsible enough to function in a college environment while managing the freedoms and stress of college.
- Students must have at least ten (10) high school credits which include: Algebra I, Geometry, English I, English II, Physical Science, Ecology, or Biology I, World History, and Lifetime Wellness. If the student is attending Westmoreland High School, he/she can substitute Algebra II for Geometry. The student will have to take Geometry through E.B. Wilson Virtual School.

Application Process

- Complete the Sumner County Middle College Application packet. This includes the application, essay, Notarized Financial Agreement, and transcript. Submit originals to the MCHS office on the VSCC campus. Or mail application to: VSCC, Middle College High School, Wood Campus Center, Suite 217B, 1480 Nashville Pike, Gallatin, TN 37066. If you mail your application, also send an e-mail to Middle.College@sumnerschools.org and we will confirm we have received the application. Please keep the confirmation as a receipt.
- Submit recommendations from a teacher of your choice and a counselor. All recommendations are given to the high school counselor to mail to the Middle College High School office.
- Submit a recent ACT score.
- When you are accepted to SCMC a separate application for Volunteer State is required. The VSCC application will not be required until MCHS Orientation Day at VSCC. This date will be announced in the student acceptance letter to the MCHS program. Do not contact VSCC or try to apply to VSCC online.
- There may be an interview process and lottery if there are more qualified applicants than spots available.
